



STEP 1 HOW TO OPERATE SAFETY

PUSH IN "ON SAFE"



PUSH FROM RIGHT FOR "OFF SAFE"

Push the Cross Bolt Safety from the left side all the way in for "on safe."

Push it all the way in from right side for "off safe."


CAUTION: KEEP THE RIFLE "ON SAFE" UNTIL YOU ARE ACTUALLY READY TO SHOOT, THEN PUSH IT TO "OFF SAFE."

STEP 2 HOW TO PUMP

Open Forearm all the way until it stops (Fig. 2). Then close it with a smooth stroke. Keep your finger off the Trigger while pumping.


Use at least 2 pumps to avoid jamming barrel with a Pellet. Never use more than 10 pumps. Velocity increase from too much pumping is very minor, but you can damage the pump mechanism.


CAUTION: DON'T PINCH HAND OR FINGERS WHEN THE FOREARM CLOSES.



STEP 3 HOW TO COCK

- A. Pull Bolt all the way back.
- B. Close Bolt all the way.
- C. Trigger will not work with Bolt open.






Aim the rifle in a SAFE DIRECTION. When you are sure of your Target and Backstop, and the area around the Target is clear, push Safety to "off safe" and squeeze the Trigger to fire.

Don't shoot at hard surfaces or water. It may bounce off and hurt you or others. Always check to see if the gun is loaded when getting it from another person or from storage. Don't put it away loaded. Backstops wear out, so always check yours before shooting into it. If you drop your gun, check it for proper function before you use it again. If any functions change, like a shorter or weaker trigger pull, this may mean worn or broken parts; don't use it again until you've had it checked by an Authorized Service Station. (A list of Service Stations is in the box with the rifle.)


Move the Rear Sight in the same direction you want the point of impact to move. To adjust left or right loosen Windage Screws. Move Elevator back to raise Sight, forward to lower it.



THINK! WHAT WILL YOU HIT IF YOU MISS THE TARGET?

IF YOUR RIFLE JAMS


- A. Do not reload.
- B. Put Rifle "on safe," pump 10 times, cock and close Bolt, aim in a SAFE DIRECTION, take "off safe," and fire.
- C. If still jammed (Fig. 6) put "on safe," open Bolt, insert a rod or straightened clothes hanger into Barrel and carefully push jammed Pellet into Loading Port. Don't try to use that Pellet again.



HOW TO OIL YOUR RIFLE

Your rifle will work best if you oil it EVERY 250 SHOTS. Put 2 or 3 drops of CROSMAN PELLGUNOIL on the pump pivot pins, on the Trigger and Safety mechanisms, and especially on the Oil Retainer in the pump mechanism (Fig. 9).

YOUR RIFLE WILL LAST LONGER AND SHOOT BETTER IF YOU KEEP IT OILED.
